The San Clemente Junior Woman's Club awarded a scholarship to a San Clemente High School student. The Fine Arts Scholarship is an annual award recognizing an outstanding San Clemente High School Senior in the Fine Arts Program.

The Fine Arts category is open to Fine Art, Photo & Video, Music, Drama, Dance, & Vocal. All Fine Art disciplines are eligible for the scholarship. The Fine Arts scholarship is sponsored by the San Clemente Junior Woman's Club and provides financial awards and community recognition to the winner.

The application forms are provided to the art teachers and counselors at the high school to distribute to students who want to apply for the scholarship. Students are to submit a portfolio with their application. The scholarship chairperson reviews the applications and portfolios, and then presents two to four finalists to the club to vote on one winner. The club held the vote online to capture as many votes as possible to determine the winner.

Our scholarship chair, Erika Schnitzer, went to the High School scholarship awards ceremony portion of the senior graduation. Erika presented the winner with their check and a certificate in front of their friends and family. With their permission the club gave praise to them on social media.

It is our goal in the next year to increase this scholarship amount to \$1500 or \$2000 to account for changing times and cost of living increases. We find this is a valuable way to spread awareness of our club and keep our connections with the local high school faculty.
