Fundraising

La Habra is a bedroom community with a population just over 60,000 residents. It is located in the very northwest corner of Orange County. With no freeway access there is very little manufacturing in the city and the larger retailers have just recently begun to build here. La Habra Woman's Club was established in 1898 and has continued to be an asset of the community since.

Fundraising this year was definitely a challenge but we did find ways to raise money to continue supporting our favorite projects. The first two fundraising projects listed were completed before we were locked down.

Project Title Super Bowl Pool **Hours** 10 **Raised \$** 500 **In Kind \$**

Members sold squares on a Super Bowl Pool. Half was paid out in prizes. The club netted \$500.

Project Title Applebee's **Hours** **Raised \$** 285 **In Kind \$**

Members, family, and friends dined at a local Applebee's. The club received 25% of the gross sales and netted \$285.

Project Title Grants **Hours** 15 **Raised \$** 2,000 **In Kind \$**

The Club Advocates for Children chairman applied for and received a \$2000 grant from La Habra Rotary to support the Club's Project Warm project which purchased 165 new coats for children the city's elementary schools. We also received a \$200 grant from La Habra Lions for this project. The Club also applied for and received \$1500 from the Orange County Small Business Grant Relief Program. This grant was to be used for operating expenses only.

Project Title Cards For A Cause **Hours** 10 **Raised \$** 800 **In Kind \$**

The Club purchased and resold boxed greeting cards from a direct sales retailer. This is an ongoing project. We found that our members outside the immediate area were also interested in this project and both purchased and sold boxes of cards.

To date we have netted \$800.

Project Title Savers Fund Raising **Hours** 20 **Raised \$** 75 **In Kind \$**

Members collected clothing, linens and other textiles which were sold by the pound to Savers. The club netted \$75.

Project Title Brag Box Hours Raised \$ 70 In Kind \$

Each meeting members are given the opportunity to “brag”, for a price, about grandchildren, etc.
This year we have netted \$70.

Project Title Recycling Hours 2 Raised \$ 15 In Kind \$

Members are asked to collect bottles and aluminum cans. This year we have made \$15.
