**ART & CULTURAL**

The Ebell Club of Fullerton was established in 1917 and shares the community with not only other community service clubs but also with another federated club. The community is an established Community and many times the service clubs are supporting the same organization.

The clubhouse was sold and the money was invested so that each year a portion is designated as philanthropy funds. A special philanthropy committee reviews all requests for donations and submits their findings to the general membership for approval. While selling the clubhouse has financially been beneficial it has caused an identity problem as many thought we had dissolved with the sale of the clubhouse.

With the advent of Covid-19 while the club members are limited in what personal service can done our Club is fortunate to be able to continue to financially support many worthwhile organizations.

The Ebell Club of Fullerton has always been a strong supporter of the arts departments at our local high school. Each year the High School Choir presents a program at our December meeting but unfortunately this year the meeting was cancelled.

The Philanthropy Committee contact the Fullerton High School Academy of Arts Chair to obtain a wish list. This year \$9,225 was donated as follows: Performing Arts \$5,000 for a video system for the students to view their performances; \$2,500 for an accompanist as this is not covered by school funds; and \$2,225 for the Visual Arts. The club was also contacted in February, 2020 and asked to help financially for a Student to attend a state choral event and the club donated \$400.
