Kiva is an international nonprofit dedicated to connecting people through lending in an effort to eliminate poverty. The loans are given to those who would not otherwise have access to credit. We wanted to support an international woman in her business venture. Our chair reviewed relevant loan applications and found a woman in Kyrgyzstan named Salkyn. She used the money for agriculture. Payments are deposited directly into her bank account and loan payments automatically deducted to repay to the lenders. The club will re-lend the money when it is all paid back.
