Project Title: <u>Tea with Alice and Me Hours 12</u> Donated \$ 0 In Kind \$ 0 Woman's Club of Fullerton members and friends celebrated the 100 th Anniversary of the League of Women Voters and the 19 th Amendment by attending a fantastic one-woman performance that took the audience to women's tearooms in Seneca, Selfridges, The National Women's Party, and Women's Bookstores. Tearooms were where women met to organize and work to win rights for women to vote. The show included hundreds of pictures and personal stories that transported us to times in the life of Alice Paul, the author of the Equal Rights Amendment. We also learned through pictures and story the history of the women's rights movement in America, at the Nation's Capitol, at Women's Rights marches and events through history. It was an empowering evening of friendship, food and learning about how far women have come, but how far we still have to go to be truly equal in society!		
Project Title: <u>Letters to Legislators</u> Hours <u>40</u> Donated \$ <u>0</u> In Kind \$ <u>0</u> Six members of the Woman's Club of Fullerton spent time reviewing the Legislative Action Center and inputting letters of support. The members responded to requests to write letters to support legislation endorsed by the GFWC. Members logged on to the GFWC Legislative Action Center, reviewed legislation and input their support to legislators.
