Project Title: ____Jump and Schout ___ Hours __15___ Donated \$_5,000__ In Kind \$__0___

In August, four Woman's Club of Fullerton members were joined by the Manager from Ocean Subaru of Fullerton to present to the Director of Jump and Schout a check for \$5,000 for 5 Augmentative and Alternative Communication devices (AAC) or an all in one speech generating device. These devices enable the recipients to be able to communicate their needs.

Jump and Schout Therapy is a multi-disciplinary facility providing specialist in Speech and Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Physical, Diagnostic and therapy services are provided both individually and in small groups to children, adolescents and adults with a range of communication and physical conditions. A representative from Jump and Schout presented us with T-shirts and beautiful art panels signed by all the therapists and a footprint butterfly. What a beautiful piece to take away! Jump and Schout is an awesome organization, we were so impressed by the tremendous work they accomplish with their clients.

Project Title: <u>FLOCK</u> Hours <u>15</u> Donated \$ <u>5,000</u> In Kind \$ <u>0</u>

The Woman's Club of Fullerton President and 8 members of the club and Managers from Ocean Subaru of Fullerton welcomed the director of Fullerton's Love of Orange County Kids (FLOCK) to present 11 Chrome book Laptops. Laptops are given to students heading off to college. FLOCKS's Mission is to end the cycle of child homelessness in Orange County. There are about 3,000 homeless children in Orange County who either live in a motel, shelter or doubled or tripled up with

Other families. FLOCK has created a scholarship program that saves these homeless children from financial worries and allows them to just be kids. This is another organization that we are so honored to help.

Woman's Club of Fullerton, Helping Hands Chair, presented to Joya Scholars Executive Director over the ear noise resistant headphones, white boards and dry erase markers for 10 distance learning students.

The students have difficulty participating in Zoom classes and tutoring sessions due to not having a reliable private and dedicated area of their home to work. Many of the students' homes have multiple students working in the same space, and with a high noise level.

Along with Ocean Subaru of Fullerton we donated these items for the students to be able to complete their schoolwork more easily. We are always glad to be able to help these hard working students.

Project Title: <u>School Headsets</u> Hours <u>8</u> Donated \$<u>3,700</u> In Kind \$<u>0</u>

The Woman's Club of Fullerton and two members from The Assistance League and Ocean Subaru of Fullerton Manager met the Principal and Social Service assistant at the Commonwealth School on December 10, 2020. The purpose of the visit was to present 350 headsets to the school for the student's distance learning curriculum.

The WCOF and Assistance league Ladies were given a tour of the school and shown how temperatures are taken in the office, of employees and children before going to their office or classrooms each day. Their system is to find out if the children and employees are ill and prevent causing further illness. The children play in certain areas always keeping social distance from other play groups. Principal Lomeli says it has been a challenge, however, they have figured it out. We are impressed on how they adapted to the ever-changing lifestyle environment due to the Pandemic.

The school staff was very appreciative on receiving the headsets for their students. We were so happy to be able to donate these headsets to the Commonwealth School children. We look forward to finding more ways to contribute to the community in these difficult times.
