Project Title: <u>El Dorado High School Choir Canopies</u> Hours <u>20</u> Donated <u>\$1500</u> In Kind <u>\$</u>

In October of 2020 the Placentia Round Table Women's Club was made aware that The El Dorado High School Combined Choir classes would not be able to meet for in-person school, as the number of students was too high for indoor social distancing due to COVID restrictions. A ler discussion and communication with the principal, choir teacher, and the choir booster organization, it was decided that the classes could meet outside if they had an overhead shelter that was large enough to accommodate 30-40 students at a time. It was decided to purchase 4 canopies that would accommodate the students, and were portable and light enough for the students to put up and take down each day. The PRT purchased these canopies for \$1500 for El Dorado High School, with the stipulation that the canopies would be made available to other classes or school events, when not in use by the Choir. Since School opened in November, the 150 choir students of EL Dorado High School have enjoyed daily Choir classes outside in a safe and sheltered atmosphere.
