Project Title: Plant Restoration Project Hours 10 Donated \$ 3,500 In- Kind \$ 100

The Woman's Club of Fullerton Conservation Chair and a committee member discussed with the Fullerton City Parks and Recreation Director a planting of a Native Plant Restoration Project at Woodcrest School in Fullerton. The intent is to spend \$3,500 on plants and soil and bark to retain the moisture in the ground. Unfortunately, due to the Covid-19 pandemic the school was shut down and the project was put on hold. When restrictions are removed the project will move forward. We are looking forward to planting vegetation that will do well in our Southern California climate.

These plants will save water, restores natural habitat for native butterflies and birds. They will provide homes for beneficial animals like possums. Most importantly it helps combat the effects of climate change. We have planted a garden at Woodcrest School before and love the interaction with the children.
