The Woman's Club of Fullerton supports KIVA as one of our international projects. It is the World's first online lending platform. We have loaned to a total of forty-nine women in countries such as Ecuador, Liberia, Nicaragua, and many more for a total of sixteen countries. Currently, we have loaned out to nineteen women. We loaned \$125 out to women in 2022. The total amount of money loaned since the start of this program is \$1,300. The repaid amount has been \$1,092.38. The loans have been to help them start a business in farming, electronics repair, grocery stores, food stalls, sewing, dairy, and beauty salon. When the money is paid back it is put back into a fund and we then make another loan to another woman to help support her family. This is a very rewarding project.
