While we cannot wait to get back into the house to serve the families, our club was honored to be able to provide meals by giving a monetary donation specifically to provide meals to the families. The Ronald McDonald House's purpose is to create a community where children and their families embrace life and healing with a sense of hope, enthusiasm, courage, and joy by keeping families close to each other and the care they need.
