Project Title Elementary Hours 6 Donated In-Kind \$2,365

There was a lot of excitement. "All of the children learn robotics and coding. Students build robots, fly drones, make video games and develop apps to benefit their community" states Dr. Castillo. The Robots will add a robotic component to the 4th-grade students' classes which have seventy students that will be using the robots. We were glad to be able to contribute to the children's education and their exploration of STEM topics like robotics.
